By 1980, Alexander Grant & Co. had merged with 49 other accounting firms, including Thornton Baker in the United Kingdom, a firm with similar attributes, clients, employee numbers, and values, to form a global corporation, and the firm's name was changed to Grant Thornton International in 1986. International business is handled by Grant Thornton member firms through their local International Business Centres, which are located in 40 major commercial centres across the world. It conducts an annual global research project called the International Business Report, which polls over 11,500 privately held enterprises from 40 countries. In June 2021 Grant Thornton LLP announced that it has partnered with nonprofit education provider NextGen Cyber Talent to build a cybersecurity curriculum for marginalised and underprivileged college-aged children in the San Francisco Bay Area.
