About the Company : Bahri, formerly known as Saudi Arabia's National Shipping Firm, is a transportation and logistics company that serves as the country's national shipping carrier. In 1978, a Royal Decree established the National Shipping Business of Saudi Arabia as a public company, with 22 per cent owned by the Saudi government's Public Investment Fund (PIF), 20 per cent by Saudi Aramco Development Company (SADCO), and the rest shares listed on the Saudi stock exchange (Tadawul). Oil, Chemicals, Logistics, Dry Bulk, and Ship Management are the five business units that make up the corporation. Transportation of crude oil, oil products, chemicals, bulk cargo, roll-on/roll-off, and ship management are all services provided by Bahri. It also owns land and properties both inside and outside of the domestic area, as well as shares in or merges with other firms, and participates in the formation of companies that perform comparable complementary operations. The Oil Transportation segment generates the most revenue for the organisation. The Saudi Arabian National Shipping Company (Bahri) announced the fulfilment of an agreement with the saline water conversion firm on January 23, 2022. Bahri's USP lies in being the world's largest owner and operator of Very Large Crude Carriers

(VLCCs) and the Middle East's largest owner and operator of chemical tanker ships. The mission statement of Bahri reads, "To be the best service provider, operating to world-class standards. We are relentless in applying responsible business fundamentals".
