Teladoc Health Inc., based in New York, United States, is a multinational telemedicine and virtual healthcare company. Telehealth, medical opinions, AI and analytics, telehealth devices, and licensable platform services are among the primary services. Teladoc Health, in particular, provides on-demand remote medical care via telephone and videoconferencing software, as well as mobile apps. Teladoc Health, the country's first and largest telemedicine company has acquired companies such as BetterHelp in 2015, Best Doctors in 2017, and Advance Medical in 2018. G.Byron Brooks EE MD and Michael Gorton founded Teladoc in Dallas, Texas in 2002. Teladoc claims to be the first telemedicine company in the United States, with a business model that allowed patients to consult with state-licensed doctors remotely at any time. It is listed on the New York Stock Exchange and is active in 130 countries and has served around 40 million members as of 2021. Teladoc have been awarded "Fast Company's Most Innovative Companies in 2021" and has also been recognized in Forbes. On February 2022, Teladoc Health announced the launch of Chronic Care Complete, a first-of-its-kind chronic condition management solution designed to help people living with multiple chronic conditions improve their health outcomes. The solution offers members a unified, comprehensive experience that includes connected health monitoring devices, access to health coaches, and when necessary, support from physicians and mental health specialists.

The USP of Teladoc Health lies in it being ranked as first in "Top 10 Telemedicine Companies in the World". The mission statement of Teledoc Health reads, "To address the full spectrum of health and well-being—not only when people are sick but also throughout their lifelong journeys to achieve better health."
