About the Company :

Exide Industries Limited is a worldwide storage battery manufacturing and life insurance company based in Kolkata, India. Under the Companies Act of 1913, Associated Battery Makers (Eastern) Ltd. was formed on January 31, 1953. The business manufactures, develops, and sells the world's largest range of lead-acid storage batteries, ranging in capacity from 2.5Ah to 20,600Ah, to meet the needs of a wide range of applications. The firm produces batteries for the automotive, electricity, telecom, infrastructure projects, computer, railways, mining, and defence industries, as well as the railways, mining, and defence sectors, using the most up-to-date technological inputs. It has manufacturing facilities in India and Sri Lanka, as well as a dealership network reaching 46 countries across five continents. Exide also owns and runs four major lead-acid battery recycling plants: two in the United States and one each in Spain and Portugal. Two in Maharashtra, two in West Bengal – Shamnagar (Mother plant) and Haldia, one in Tamil Nadu – Hosur, one in Haryana, and two in Uttarakhand — the company has seven factories across the country. Exide is the only business that supplies the Indian Navy with submarine batteries. As of January 2022, the company leverages the talent of 1,973 employees.

Exide Industries' USP lies in its being India's largest and fourth-largest maker of automotive and industrial lead-acid batteries. The mission statement of the company reads, "To become a Global Power House respected by customers and preferred by investors, known for innovative products and solutions. To outperform a market exceeding expectations of customers and shareholders through the accelerated evolution of people, processes and technologies in its journey towards excellence".
