Naturgy Energy Group S. A. Naturgy Energy Group S.A., originally Gas Natural Fenosa, is a multinational Spanish natural gas and electrical energy utilities firm based in Spain. The administrative headquarters of the corporation are in Barcelona, and the legal headquarters are in Madrid. In 1843, it began as Sociedad Catalana para el Alumbrado for Gas (SCAG), one of the first organisations to offer light to Barcelona's streets and public areas. Gas Distribution, Electricity Distribution, Gas, Electricity, and Rest are the segments in which it operates. The Gas Distribution division covers the regulated gas distribution operation, as well as services for third-party network access and distribution-related activities. The Energy Distribution segment provides customers with regulated electricity distribution and network services. Gas infrastructure, supply activities, and Unión Fenosa Gas make up the Gas section. The Electricity segment includes activities such as generation and marketing in Spain, as well as Global Power Generation. The rest of the part deals with the exploitation of Kangra Coal (Proprietary) Ltd's coal resource in South Africa. On June, 2021, Telstra and Naturgy reported that they had signed a power purchase agreement (PPA) to construct a 58-megawatt (MW) wind farm near Goulburn, New South Wales. Naturgy has announced plans for reorganization in 2022 by separating current businesses under two distinct entities – one managing the liberalised businesses and the other managing regulated energy distribution and transmission infrastructure.

Naturgy Energy Groups' USP lies in its being the leading Spanish energy company that serves over 18 million clients globally providing gas and electricity. The mission statement of Naturgy reads, "To respond to the energy needs of society by offering quality and environmentally-friendly products and services".
