About the Company :

The Philippine Long Distance Telephone Company was renamed PLDT, Inc., a holding company for telecommunications, internet, and digital services. The company has its headquarters in Makati City, Metro Manila. Along with Globe Telecom and the nascent Dito Telecommunity, it is one of the country's main telecom carriers. An ordinance of the Philippine Government created PLDT on November 18, 1928. The business provides wireless broadband, voice, data, and cellular services. Additional fixed-line services offered by the company include local exchange, international long-distance, data and other networks, and other services. Through several brands, including TNT, SmartBro, Sun Broadband, PLDT, Smart, and Sun Cellular, the firm advertises its services. These solutions are made accessible to corporate, retail, and SME clients. The Philippines, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, and Singapore are all commercial hubs for the organisation. On July 7, 2022, PLDT Inc., Smart Communications, Inc. (Smart), a wireless division of PLDT Inc., and the MVP Sports Foundation (MVP SF) announced that they were supporting the Philippine Olympic Committee's (POC) initiative to create a trust fund to provide incentives to national athletes who win medals at the Olympics, Southeast Asian Games, and Asian Games.

The unique selling proposition or USP of PLDT is that it is the largest fully integrated telco in the Philippines and has one of the highest market capitalizations among listed firms in the country. The mission statement of PLDT reads, "Empower Filipinos everywhere with customer-focused digital innovations that unlock and share their infinite potential".
