About the Company :

The Metsä Group (formerly known as Metsäliitto Group) is a company in the forest business that uses renewable wood from sustainably managed forests. The business's main office is located in Helsinki, Finland. The parent firm of Metsä Group, Metsäliitto Cooperative, can trace its roots to the cooperative movement, which began to take place in Finland around the turn of the 20th century. In 1947, Metsäliitto was established as a cooperative company. The primary industries of the company include wood products (Metsä Wood), board (Metsä Board), the pulp (Metsä Fibre), tissue and cooking papers (Metsä Tissue), as well as wood trading and forestry services (Metsä Forest). The Metsä Group has about 9,500 employees as of early 2022. Nearly 100,000 Finnish forest owners are members of Metsäliitto Cooperative, the main company of Metsä Group. By committing to a membership with the Ellen MacArthur Foundation, Metsä Group joined the largest circular economy network in the world in June 2022.

Metsä Group's USP lies in its being a pioneer in a sustainable economy, using renewable wood from sustainably managed northern forests, and its Metsä Wood division is a world leader in the production of engineered wood goods. The mission statement of the company reads, "Advancing bio-economy and circular economy by efficiently processing northern wood into first-class products".
