About the Company :

Credit Suisse Group AG is a Swiss-based multinational investment bank and financial services corporation. It is one of the nine global "Bulge Bracket" banks, with headquarters in Zürich and offices in all major financial centres around the world, offering services in investment banking, private banking, asset management, and shared services. Credit Suisse was established in 1856 to fund the expansion of Switzerland's rail system. It made loans that aided in the development of Switzerland's electrical grid and the European train system. It began transitioning to retail banking in the 1900s in reaction to the rise of the middle class and competition from neighboring Swiss banks UBS and Julius Bär. Credit Suisse formed a joint venture with First Boston in 1978 before acquiring a majority stake in the bank in 1988. From 1990 to 2000, the corporation acquired Winterthur Group, Swiss Volksbank, Swiss American Securities Inc. (SASI), and Bank Leu. It has won awards in various categories of the Euromoney Awards for Excellence 2022. Credit Suisse employees over 50,110 people as of early 2022.

The USP of Credit Suisse lies in it being the market leader in wealth management in Switzerland. The mission of Credit Suisse is driven by the purpose "We build lasting value by serving our clients with care and entrepreneurial spirit."
