Severn Trent is a water utility with its headquarters in Coventry, England. The company's registered trademark, Severn Trent, refers to a collection of businesses having operations in the Middle East, the United States, mainland Europe, and the United Kingdom. In 1974, the Severn Trent Water Authority was founded. In July 1989, the Water Act partially privatised the Severn Trent Water Authority along with the rest of the water supply and sewage disposal industry in England and Wales to create Severn Trent Water. It got its name from the two previous River Authorities, which oversaw the Trent and Severn River catchments. Eight million residential and commercial customers in the British Midlands receive water and sewage services from Severn Trent PLC. In addition, Severn Trent has expanded into several associated industries, such as waste management, water technology services, and the development of software systems for various industrial uses. The business has expanded outside of its market as well, taking part in a variety of operational and consultancy ventures abroad. The company has collaborated with Connexin in 2022 to implement IoT and smart technology across its network.

Severn Trent's unique selling point lies in its being the largest water utility in Britain, affecting the lives of millions of people throughout the Midlands. The mission statement of the company reads, "To serve our customers and communities"
