Dana Inc. offers power-conveyance and energy-management solutions for machinery and vehicles. The business, which was established in 1904 and is headquartered in Maumee, Ohio, has close to 36,000 employees worldwide. The business provides driveshafts, axles, transmissions, and electrodynamic, thermal, sealing, and digital equipment for conventional, hybrid, and electric cars. Markets for light vehicles, commercial vehicles, and off-highway equipment are targeted by the company's goods and services. Automobiles, industries, and financial holdings make up Dana's three main business sectors. Four regional organisations in North America, South America, Europe, and the Asia Pacific are in charge of the company's global operations under its decentralised management structure.
