TIAA manages assets with holdings in more than 50 countries and provides services to over 5 million active and retired employees participating at more than 15,000 institutions. The organization was founded in 1918 by Andrew Carnegie and his Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching under the leadership of Henry S. Pritchett as a fully funded system of pensions for academics. With taxable subsidiaries, it is now set up as a nonprofit corporation. The TIAA decision established how much of its income to distribute each year to TIAA Traditional account policyholders. As of March 2022, there were 146 offices in the United States, with New York serving as the headquarters. On September 7, 2022, TIAA stated that it had partnered with Google Cloud to use its artificial intelligence (AI) technology to improve analysis for more efficient interactions in its National Contact Center (NCC), optimize self-service, and increase
