Its franchise area of about 9,685 km2 represents for only 3% of the Philippines' total land area yet accounts for 55% of the country's electrical output. Meralco will be celebrating 119 years of service in 2022, and is dedicated to providing reliable and inexpensive energy. The Manila Electric Company (Meralco) was recognised for displaying excellence in stakeholder communication at the recently concluded Gold Quill Awards, one of the most prestigious business communication awards programmes in the world. As of early 2022, the Manila Electric Company employees more than 5,000 people.
