Johnson Controls International plc is an American – Irish multinational company headquartered in Cork, Ireland. The company was formed in 2016 via the merger of Johnson Controls, an American company, with Tyco International. It specializes in three primary businesses – building efficiency, automotive experience and power solutions, serving customers in more than 150 countries. The company employed 105,000 people in approximately 2,000 locations across six continents. In 2017, as the company was headquartered outside the U.S, it became eligible for the Fortune 500. Its Fortune 500 ranking in 2020 was 439. Johnson Controls is presented with five honours from the Manufacturing Leadership Council, including the Engineering & Production Technology Leadership Award, the Enterprise Integration Technology Leadership Award, the Operational Excellence Leadership Award, the Plant Tour Award, and the High Achiever Award in the Enterprise Integration Technology Leadership Award. Tempered Networks, a Seattle, Washington-based provider of zero trust cybersecurity, was acquired by Johnson Controls in June 2022. The acquisition advances Johnson Controls' goal of enabling fully autonomous buildings that are inherently resistant to cyberattack by enabling zero trust security within the framework of its OpenBlue secure communications stack.

Johnson Controls' Unique Selling Proposition lies in it being, 'World class supplier of power solutions and interiors for a wide variety of automobiles. Johnson Controls' mission statement reads "We advance the safety, comfort and intelligence of spaces to power your mission", and its vision is, "A safe, comfortable and sustainable world".
