The company was founded in 2004 as a merger between IMC Global and Cargill's crop nutrition division, and is headquartered in Tampa, Florida. Mosaic's primary business is the mining and production of phosphate and potash fertilizers, which are essential nutrients for plant growth and are used in the production of a wide variety of crops, including corn, soybeans, and wheat. The company operates mines and production facilities across North and South America, including in Florida, Louisiana, Saskatchewan, and Brazil. In addition to its core fertilizer business, Mosaic also has a presence in the agricultural retail sector through its subsidiary, The Mosaic Company Retail. This division operates a network of retail locations across the United States and Canada, selling fertilizer, seed, and other agricultural products directly to farmers and growers. As of 2023, the company employed 13,570 people.

The USP of the company is that it is one of the largest and most influential players in the global agricultural industry, with a focus on sustainable and responsible production practices. The mosaic company's vision statement reads, "Together we advance an inclusive and thriving Canada."
