The company expanded into electricity supply in the early 20th century, and into heat supply in the 1960s. It also acquired a water supply company in the 1990s. It is committed to sustainability. Mainova has set ambitious targets for reducing its emissions. By 2030, the company aims to reduce its CO2 emissions by 50% compared to 2019 levels. It is investing heavily in renewable energy sources, such as solar and wind power. In 2022, the company invested 1 billion in renewable energy projects. It is also a member of the Climate Alliance, a network of cities and regions committed to climate action. Mainova AG had 3,080 employees as of March 31, 2023.
