#### About the Company:

Chevron Corporation is an American multinational oil and gas major headquartered in San Ramon, California. Established in 1870 as a part of its predecessor company Standard Oil; Chevron is one of the largest oil and gas companies globally with presence across the oil and gas value chain. Chevron's operations are divided into two business units: Upstream unit and Downstream unit. Upstream unit operations consist primarily of exploration, development and production of crude oil and natural gas; processing, liquefaction, transportation and regasification of liquefied natural gas; movement of crude oil by major international oil export pipelines, transportation, storage, marketing and selling of natural gas and a gas-to-liquid conversion plant. Downstream unit operations consist of refining crude oil into petroleum products, marketing and selling of crude oil and its refined products, transportation of crude oil and refined products by marine vessel unit, motor equipment and pipelines and manufacturing and marketing of commodity petrochemicals and fuel and lubricant additives. Chevron Corp comprises of 42,595 employees as of early 2023.

Chevron's USP or Unique Selling Proposition sprawls in being one of the world's largest oil companies with complete integration ranging from producing, refining, marketing, and distribution. Chevron's mission is that "We are committed to delivering the energy that improves lives and enables human progress, within a company culture defined by trust, responsibility and integrity.
