About the Company: OneOK Inc. is a diversified natural gas company headquartered in Tulsa, Oklahoma. In 1906, the company was founded and named Oklahoma natural gas company and later it changed its corporate name to ONEOK in December 1980. It leverages the talent of around 2,800 employees as of early 2021. OneOk's Energy Services operation's focal point is on marketing natural gas and services related to it throughout U.S. OneOK owns one of the nation's premier natural gas liquids ("NGL") systems, joining NGL supply in the Rocky Mountain, Permian and Mid-Continent regions with main market center and a large-scale network of natural gas gathering, processing, storage and transportation assets. It applies its core capabilities of gathering, processing, fractionating, transporting, storing and marketing natural gas and NGLs through vertical integration across the midstream value chain to supply its customers with premium services while generating consistent and sustainable earnings growth. In 1907, ONG (Oklahoma Natural Gas) constructed a natural gas pipeline from the Osage fields to Oklahoma City and also built the first gas pipeline compressor station in the state in 1910. In 2020, the company expects to increase its growth through increased NGLs from Rocky Mountain region and Permain Basin operation to the Gulf Coast market center. In 2018, ONEOK received the 2018 Horizon Award from the Chamber of Commerce in Sidney, Montana. It recognizes businesses breaking new ground and moving forward.

OneOK's USP or Unique Selling Proposition lies in it being a leading midstream service provider in United States. OneOK's mission statement reads, "We provide responsive, flexible service to customers, and commit to preserving the environment, providing a safe work environment and improving the quality of life for employees where they live and work".
