In 1940, the business was set up by two cousins David Gabriel Smith and David Solomon Smith to build cartons. The business was listed on the London Stock Exchange later in 1950s. The company operates in packaging - corrugated packaging, plastic packaging and recycled paper in 37 countries. The company has around 27,500 employees as of early 2021. This multinational company also makes use of infrastructure of the countries in which they operate such as energy provider, telecommunication and transportation network. The company is funded by an amalgamation of shareholder equity, debt and cash flow generated through its operations. In 2020, the charitable foundation of the company made its mark on local communities by responding to Covid-19 through innovative packages for vulnerable citizens and donations around the world. The company has been awarded for three of it's innovative packaging solutions prized with 2020 World Star Packaging Award, which are, The Tuorekartano Oy potato fridge-box, The Maggi 'Food Travel' display and The Red Bull Event car. The company believes in generating sustainable value which is found in balancing the needs of it's business, environment and it's people.
