About the Company : Phoenix Group Holdings plc is a provider of insurance services headquartered in London, England, United Kingdom. It is a global corporation that is a part of the FTSE 100 Index and is listed on the London Stock Exchange. In 1857, the company was founded as The Pearl Loan Company and was operated from the Royal Oak Public House and later in 2010 The Pearl Group was renamed as Phoenix Group Holdings. The company's operation consists of five distinct business divisions that aggressively market goods to new and existing customers. Under the Standard Life name, the Workplace Pensions and Customer Savings & Investments ("CS&I") divisions produce long-term savings and retirement products to help people save for their future. Open's Retirement Solutions unit involves both vesting annuities and its Bulk Purchase Annuity ("BPA") service, in which the company buys annuities and provides the financial flexibility needed to protect corporate pensions. Lastly, the Open business includes the company's market-leading brand, "SunLife," which offers a variety of financial goods targeted to the over 50s market, as well as the company's European business unit, which operates under the Standard Life brand in Ireland, Germany, and the Foreign Bond segment in the United Kingdom. In 2021, Phoenix announced that it has purchased the rights to the Standard Life brand and had taken additional measures to simplify the partnership with Standard Life Aberdeen that had formed since the acquisition of Standard Life company.

The Phoenix Group's Unique Selling Proposition or USP lies in it being the UK's largest long-term savings and retirement business. The Phoenix Group's vision statement reads, "Our vision is to grow a strong and sustainable business to help more people on their journey to and through retirement, enabling us to improve outcomes for customers and deliver value for shareholders".
