Individuals and small businesses can use the bank's lending services, as well as liability products, card services, Internet banking, automated teller machine (ATM) services, depository, financial advisory, and NRI services. The RBI's list of NEFT-enabled banks includes Axis Bank. In April 2021, Axis Bank and its subsidiaries became co-promoters of Max Life Insurance Company Limited ("Max Life") after the Axis Entities completed the acquisition of a 12.99 per cent stake in

Axis Bank's Unique Selling Point or USP lies in it being one of the leading private sector agricultural lenders in India.
